We are pleased to inform you of the details of the golf day competition as part of the All Class Champion Reunion festivities of June 9th to 11th 2023 in Chicago.

Harborside is located at 11001 S. Doty Ave East, Chicago, IL 60628 (312) 782-7837 extension #5 for the Pro Shop. The course is approximately 25-30 minutes drive due south from Water Tower Place on north Michigan Ave in Chicago. Water Tower is the nexus point of the All Class Reunion being one block from reunion's accommodation facilities at the Drake Hotel and Baumhart Hall of Loyola on East Pearson.

Harborside International's **Port Course**, which opened for play in 1995, immediately garnered national attention and has since been acclaimed as Chicago's top public course. This challenging links course was designed by Dick Nugent in the true links tradition of windswept, Scottish courses. While it may seem like you are playing a course built for The Open Championship, the spectacular views of Chicago's iconic skyline will remind you how close you are to home.

The Port Course is 5,977 yards and include amongst the fantastic finishing hole of the famed par 3 #15 "Anchor Hole" immediately followed by three holes bordering the harbor waters of Lake Calumet. The Harborside golf superintendent worked at Medinah during the Ryder Cup in 2012.

When? Friday June 9th, 2023. There will be a 9:00 a.m Scramble shotgun start with an All-Class competition.

Golf Staging and Practice Range Shuttle – The Golf Cart staging will be located just outside the front entrance to the Clubhouse with the players' name, course and starting hole listed. This will logistically allow for an easier process for guests. Harborside ambassadors will greet golfers upon arrival and direct us to our assigned Cart via the alphabetized name sheet list provided. Once golf bags have been secured, players will

be directed to registration and/or the Dining room. After check-in, players will have an option to board the shuttle (also located in front of the Clubhouse) for practice at our Range facility. Golfers are kindly asked to report to their Carts 20 minutes prior to the actual start time so a few short announcements can be made and then golfers will be led to their starting holes.

All golfers should plan on registering and paying up no later than 08:30 for the event. Parking is free. Coffee, juice and doughnuts will be available prior to tee off.

There is a halfway house on the course. Beverage carts will be circulating as of 10:00 am

The Competition

A Shotgun Scramble Competition format between all Classes of Champion. Lowest gross score wins.

All final score ties will be broken by picking the #1 rated handicap hole on the respective course and the lowest score on that hole will break the tie. If a tie still exists, we will go forward hole by hole with the next higher Scramble Event Rules

Rules of the Competition

Teams are instructed to pick up after a bogey is scored to help with speed of play.

Campion golfers Tee off from the White Markers at 5,977 yards and Campion Seniors aged 72 +(Campion Classes of 1969 or earlier) will tee off, at their choice, on the red forward tees measuring 5,164 yards.

All players will hit their own drive from the respective tee box on each hole and then the team will select the best tee shot of the group. All players will then hit their next shot from that spot within one club-length, no closer to the hole. This process is used on all shots including putts until the hole is completed (bogey is max score). All balls must stay within the condition they are found in (i.e A ball in the rough must be played from the rough), putts can be given if within one putter head-length no closer to the hole The Harborside Pro Shop will provide the winning score information after every team has recorded or turned in their scores.

If a team has 3 players, they may alternate within the threesome taking a fourth shot.

Prizes will be awarded for the following achievements.

1. Lowest Gross 18 hole score by a class team.

2. Closest individual tee shot to the pin on # 15.
3. Longest drive on the par 5 18th.
4. Shortest drive on the par 5 18th.

Please note the GPS systems in the carts at Harborside provide a real time leaders board throughout the event.

Non Golfers and Referees

Our outing will be provided with a max of 4 additional Golf Carts (Par 3 volunteers, staff, referees, or photographers) to use throughout the duration of the tournament. All drivers must be at least 21 years old and have a valid State issued Driver's License. Any additional carts (if available and pre-approved) will incur a \$25 fee.

Please submit names of non golfers 7 days prior to the tournament.

How Much?

The cost per player of \$142.50 charge includes the box lunch and 18 Hole Greens fee, shared GPS Golf Cart, a bucket of practice balls, Golf Cart staging in front of the Clubhouse, player greeting upon arrival, table registration set up, up to (2) Golf carts provided for volunteers, up to (4) tables and (8) chairs placed on the course in advance, sponsor signs set up on the course, practice facility shuttle, starters, rangers, names on carts and scorecards, Golf Genius app with live scoreboard, final scores tabulated, proxy contest signs set up and then collected for prize winners and A/V set up in the dining room.

BOX LUNCH - (Ham, Turkey or Veggie Wrap sandwich with a bag of chips, fresh baked cookie, whole fruit and a soft drink or water) per player.

Admin Charge

We are identifying any additional costs if any and will notify you of any charges. These minimal costs will provide for Champion golf swag for the day and event prizes.

Awards Ceremony

Harborside has requested we complete the round in 4.5 hours of play. We will have the awards ceremony at 1:30 pm in the bar.

We intend to close the festivities in time for golfers to return to their accommodations in time to shower, change and catch the buses from the Drake and Loyola early evening to the River Boat Dinner Cruise on the Calypso.

Discounted parking is being organized at the Drake or Loyola U for those driving and attending Reunion events later in the day.

Sign Up and Payment

We currently have reserved for 72 golfers equaling 18 four balls. Should demand prove higher we need to inform Harborside as early as possible so please let us know of your interest ASAP.

To reserve space for your group please send an email to our attention at the link below and list the names of your group. We will be putting out instructions for deposits to be paid of \$142.50 per four ball group or lesser amounts for smaller groups in the very near future.

Balance of payments for the golf outing will be done on the day at registration.

Individuals, two balls and three balls are most welcome and will be grouped into a four ball with fellow Champion alumni closest to their year of graduation.

If your wife is interested in playing or supervising your team's scorekeeping, please let us know ASAP.

Rain Out

Rain is a playing condition but if there is lightning or dangerous wind conditions, players will be called off the course and Harborside will wait until play can be resumed. If the event is rained out and no golf is played, players will not pay for the golf portion. If players show up, we will have all of the F&B pre-planned ready to be served and Harborside will collaborate with the coordinators on a fair and equitable price per person.
